

I, undersigned Arnold Koltai, President of the Student Council of University of Pécs, pursuant to the Central Dormitory Committee of the Student Council of University of Pécs, announce

## the election of the members (5) of Szántó Dormitory Student Committe

(1) The tender is appliable for all those: who has a valid contract with the given dormitory and who submits a valid application for the tender to the directorate of the Student Council of University of Pécs. The member candidates of the Dormitory Student Committee are obligated to reach the 10% of the given dormitory's resident's recommendatory signature.

(2) The condition to take part in the election is to meet the requirements of the tender.

(3) The tender has to contain:

a) the candidate's CV,

b) the candidate's motivational letter,

c) the copy of the valid dormitory contract,

d) 10% of the given dormitory's resident's recommendatory signature,

e) certificate of studies prepared by the registrars department which is not older than 15 days,

f) each and every page of the application form has to be signed by the candidate,

g) the candidate's planned program.

(4) If any requirement of the points stated above (1., 2., 3.) is not met or fulfilled then the tender/application is denied without hesitation.

(5) The application deadline: from 10. september 2019. (tuesday) 10:00 - until 30. september 2019. (monday) 16:00

(6) Submission address: PTE Student Council of University of Pécs's office, 7622 Pécs, Vasvári Pál str. 4.

(7) The Dormitory Student Committee's members are elected by the delegates of the Student Council of University of Pécs by simple majorty until the next result of the Dormitory Student Committee's election, but for a year most.

(8) The mandate of the members starts on the first working day after the election. If the previous Dormitory Student Committee's mandate has not expired, then the mandate of the members starts on the first working day after the expiration.
